### **About This Document**

This Community Marketing Toolkit is a supplemental, non-regulatory resource intended to support consistent, compliant local promotion of the Match on Main program. It is designed for use by communities and Downtown Development Authorities (DDAs) and may be posted as a downloadable resource alongside other Match on Main materials.

### **Branding & Usage Guardrails**

Communities may:

### **Community Website Copy – Short Blurb**

Match on Main is a locally administered reimbursement grant program that supports new and expanding businesses located in downtowns and main street corridors. Eligible businesses may receive up to \$25,000 for approved project expenses such as interior renovations, technology, marketing, or outdoor space activation. Funding is limited and awarded through a competitive process. Interested businesses should contact the City or DDA for local application details.

### **Community Website Copy – Expanded Version**

Match on Main is a state-funded reimbursement grant program designed to support small business growth and place-based investment in downtowns and main street corridors. The program is administered locally by the City, DDA, or other designated management entity.

Eligible businesses may be awarded up to \$25,000 to support approved project costs such as interior building improvements, technology upgrades, marketing and branding, or activation of outdoor spaces. Funding is provided on a reimbursement basis.

Applications are reviewed competitively at the local level, and funding is limited. Not all

applications will be awarded. Businesses should contact the City or DDA for guidance on the local application process.

### **Eligible Expense Examples (Non-Exhaustive)**

Interior Improvements: flooring, lighting, drywall, interior layout

Technology: point-of-sale systems, inventory or scheduling software, website or e-commerce development

Marketing: logo and brand development, professional photography, digital or print marketing materials

Outdoor Activation: outdoor seating, lighting, planters, wayfinding elements
