



City of Evart Downtown Infrastructure 200 South Main Street, Evart COMPLETED 2015

Project overview

The Michigan Strategic Fund approved \$623,556 for Downtown Infrastructure Grant (DIG) funds for public infrastructure improvements in downtown Evart. The project included streetscape and sidewalk improvements including bumpouts and ADA additions along Main Street in downtown Evart. The project included a pocket park with the addition of water efficient public restrooms. Rain gardens and an electric car charging station were also installed.

MEDC investment: \$625,500 Community Development Block Grant

Local investment: \$69,200



Limited charging infrastructure for electric vehicles (EV) has been one of the main barriers for adopting these vehicles. The Michigan Energy Office (MEO) supports development of a direct current fast charging network providing worry-free EV travel throughout Michigan by 2030. In February 2019, the MEO released a report, "Electric Vehicle Charger Placement Optimization in Michigan: Phase I–Highways", to optimize EV charger placement in Michigan.
