Project overview

After suffering a devastating fire in 2007, local fundraising efforts, coupled with MEDC Community Development funds, helped renovate the Joseph H. Lebowsky Theatre located in downtown Owosso. Prior to the fire, the Lebowsky Center was the largest-drawing venue in the city. The completely rehabilitated and fully operational 550-seat theater opened in May 2014 to a sold-out crowd.
