





## ACT 381 BROWNFIELD PLAN PUBLIC HEARING NOTIFICATION

The Brownfield Redevelopment Financing Act, 1996 PA 381, as amended (Act 381) requires notification to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA), or its designee, and the Michigan Strategic Fund (MSF), or its designee, of a Brownfield Plan that involves the use of taxes levied for school operating purposes for activities that require approval of a Work Plan by any agency. Specifically, Section 14(4) of Act 381 requires that **not less than ten days** before the hearing on the Brownfield Plan the governing body shall provide notice of the hearing to EGLE if the Brownfield Plan involves the use of taxes levied for school operating purposes to pay for eligible activities that require the approval of a Combined Brownfield Plan or a Work Plan by EGLE under section 13b(6)(c), MSHDA, or its designee, if the Brownfield Plan involves the use of taxes levied for school operating purposes to pay for eligible activities subject to subsection 13b(4)b, and the MSF, or its designee, if the Brownfield Plan involves the use of taxes levied for school operating purposes to pay for eligible activities subject to subsection 13b(4)b.

This notification is intended to give EGLE, MSHDA and MSF information about future projects and to stimulate communication between EGLE, MSHDA, MSF, the local units of government, and the brownfield redevelopment authorities. *Contact with EGLE, MSHDA, and MSF regarding future projects earlier than ten days is recommended and appreciated!*
