Project overview

The city of Houghton has rejuvenated downtown's Shelden Avenue with the restoration of four historic, multi-story building exterior rehabilitation projects.

Extensive rehabilitation to the buildings included complete storefront reconstruction; painting; signage; awnings; window and door replacement; wall restoration; and improved lighting.

The project has had a tremendous aesthetic impact while improving foot traffic for the occupying businesses.
