



Geenen DeKock Properties 44 West Eighth Street, Holland COMPLETED 2019

Project overview

This high-priority, infill development is located on the western end of downtown Holland's principal shopping district. The project, completed by Geenen DeKock Properties LLC, is a multi-phase project which encompassed an entire city block. The work included the complete renovation of the existing Holland Sentinel Building, the construction of two new mixed-use structures containing over 30,000 square feet of new retail space, 32 new market-rate residential units, and a new 27,000-square-foot multiplex theater. The balance of the project will include the demolition of seven buildings, construction of three or four new mixed-use buildings, a new 380-space parking deck built by City of Holland, and complete improvements to the city's Civic Center.
