## **Dear Certified Local Government:**

The State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) is now accepting fiscal year (FY) 2026 Certified Local Government (CLG) grant applications. Funds are available for documentation, education, and community-based preservation planning projects, as well as pre-development and development activities.

Grant Eligibility: Only local units of government that have been certified as part of the CLG

program prior to the grant application deadline may apply for grant funding. CLGs may sponsor projects for non-profit organizations and public entities within their boundaries, so long as the project meets CLG

grant program eligibility. A list of current CLGs is available at

**Match Requirements:** There is no match requirement for FY26 CLG grant projects.
