	Up to 35	Critical Improvements <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Had experienced infrastructure failure but has been secured ▪ Application demonstrates Indirect Impacts such as Impact Reports or Assessments, Public Feedback, or Government issued plans that recommend mitigation 	
	Up to 15	Future Growth/Mitigation <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Project is proactive in nature and does not address an immediate need, but encompasses mitigation or resiliency measures for future disasters
