Davison Downtown Façades

219, 225, 229 North Main Street, Davison

Project overview

City of Davison, in partnership with local property owners, performed transformational façade improvements to three buildings in the traditional downtown. The three downtown buildings, located at 219, 225, and 229 North Main Street, improved the façades to restore the character and historical appearance, while attracting new customers and visitors to the downtown area. CDBG funds were used for storefront restoration, historical feature preservation, new windows and doors, and masonry repair.

MEDC investment: \$153,556 in Community Development Block Grant

Local contribution: \$27,000 City of Davison Downtown Development Authority

Private investment: \$27,623
